## **The 1<sup>st</sup> Davis Recycled Art Faire and Silent Auction is a juried art show.**

<u>Categories</u>	<u>2 different Classes</u>		
Grades Students 7 through 9	Individual	or	Team
Grades 10 through 12	Individual	or	Team
Local college & university	Individual	or	Team
Amateur & Professional	Individual	or	Team

### **100 Point Scoring by Judges:**

Originality	25 points
Composition	25 points
Media quality	25 points
Creativity	25 points

### **Elementary grades (Kindergarten through 6th) are invited to participate with Craft Sales.**

Twenty spaces available; each includes a 2-foot round table. Classrooms, recycle leaders, garden leaders are invited to participate with craft sales from the school sites. The same guidelines and entry requirements apply with the exception of craft sales. All funds received will return to your participating group or classroom.

### **Guidelines:**

- There is no entry fee for any participant
- Entries must be made from materials, which have been previously used, destined to be discarded or recycled.
- Using new materials purchased for the entry is not allowed and will disqualify the entry. The only new items allowed for construction of art pieces include construction materials such as paint, glue, tape, screws, and nails.
- Must bring own equipment and supplies for displaying art piece....Table, free standing, hanging, etc.
- Submit completed entry form by Wednesday, November 9, 2005 to Dorothy Peterson at one of two locations. (1) By mail to Pioneer School, 5215 Hamel Street, Davis, CA 95616 or (2) online at [www.davisrise.org](http://www.davisrise.org)
- Each artist will choose whether to participate in the silent auction. Each entry must specify whether the item will be for sale or not for sale (NFS). If the item will be for sale, the entry form should specify what amount, between 10% and 100% will be donated to the participant's school or to the RISE program's general fund.
- Upon arriving, each entry will be numbered and tagged according to entry form.
- A minimum bid will be set by submitting artist(s) along with the percentage of sale donated to the artist's school or to the Davis Educational Foundation's Farm to School Program for RISE use in the Davis Schools.
- Each artist is to set up and display his or her own work.
- The 3<sup>rd</sup> and B Street Building basement will be used for the Faire if weather is unstable.
- Participation awards will be given to all artists and crafters by California Integrated Waste Management Board.

### **Scheduled timeline for Saturday, November 19, 2005**

8 to 9 AM	Set up art pieces and craft displays
9 to 10 AM	Open Judging....This means that the artists are welcome to listen. Talking is not allowed during the hour of judging.
10 to 2 PM	Art Faire Show, Silent Auction, and elementary craft sales
2 PM	Silent Auction closed
2:30 PM	Artists collect all unsold art pieces
