

MATERIALS ACCEPTED FREE OF CHARGE AT THE YOLO COUNTY CENTRAL LANDFILL

Material	Additional Information
AGRICULTURAL PESTICIDE PLASTIC DRUMS OR CONTAINERS (EMPTY & CERTIFIED TRIPLE RINSED)	In order to be accepted, they must be certified triple rinsed (contact Yolo County Ag Dept.), dry, non-refillable, HDPE plastic crop protection and other EPA registered pesticide product containers from agricultural and professional end users and must be containers that hold 55 gallons or less. They must not be from home, garden, antimicrobial products, veterinary products or other noncommercial uses. No containers larger than 55 gallons can be accepted unless written approval is obtained, no pesticide or other crop protection containers that were never filled, filled and never distributed or were subject of a recall.
ALUMINUM CANS	Aluminum beverage containers should be rinsed
BATTERIES	Nickel cadmium (Nicads, or NiCd), alkaline, nickel metal hydride (Ni-MH), Lithium Ion (Li-ion), and small sealed Lead (Pb), large sealed lead (car, motorcycle, etc.) can all be recycled free of charge. Please do not dispose of batteries as waste (with the exception of zinc carbon batteries which cannot be recycled)
CARDBOARD	Corrugated cardboard (shipping boxes, etc.,)
ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT WITHOUT CATHODE RAY TUBES (cathode ray tubes are typically found in televisions and computer monitors)	Keyboards, typewriters, CPU's, cell phones, fax machines, stereos, VCRs, etc., can all be recycled free of charge. Please do not dispose as waste (even if broken). Copy machines will be accepted only if all toners and liquids have been removed prior to bringing to the landfill.
GLASS	Glass beverage containers should be rinsed, paper labels are ok and the metal lids and caps should be recycled with other metals
INERTS	Clean soil, clean gravel, clean asphalt grindings or workable hot asphalt. Subject to inspection and approval by staff. Free of any litter or contamination. No mixtures with the exception of clean soil mixed with clean gravel. ALL SOIL LOADS REQUIRE APPROVAL PRIOR TO DELIVERY! (Soil Acceptability Criteria)
<u>OIL</u> & OIL FILTERS	5-gallon limit for motor oil
PAPER	Newspaper, junk mail, paper grocery bags, phone books, white paper, colored paper, magazines, envelopes
PLASTIC	Plastic bottles (#1-2) should be rinsed and the plastic lids and caps should be discarded
PVC Piping	Any colors of PVC pipe can be recycled as long it is PVC (should be printed on the pipe). No other kinds of plastic pipe can be recycled.
TIN CANS	Must be rinsed
